## Racehorse training gallops morning

The horses are trained in succession in 6 different groups every morning (5 groups on Saturdays). The exact date and time for the visit can be arranged with Annalisa Balding (or Anne Ireland can assist with arrangements if preferred). Saturdays tend to be busier at the stables with owner visits, so a mid-week visit would be preferable. The usual format is for people to arrive at 8.10am ready for a coffee before going out to see the horses warm up in the trotting ring, then go out to one of the gallops areas to see them in full training. When back from the gallops you will be shown round the stables, and then back to the house for breakfast.

Bidders need to be prepared to get up early to drive to Kingsclere. Public transport is not a practical option. If the M25 and M3 are clear, then travel time without stops is around 90 minutes. With the current roadworks around the Wisley interchange it is probably better to allow a couple of hours.

This is a really friendly and welcoming yard and the winning bidder is sure to have a wonderful experience!
